Our volunteers make a difference! Southeast Nebraska CASA Serves 5 counties. (Seward, Saline, Jefferson, Thayer and Gage) Today, 50 children are being served by a CASA volunteer in our 5 counties, however, 30 kids are still waiting for a volunteer.






