Children who have experienced abuse or neglect are involved with multiple systems - the court system, the child welfare system, the health care system, and the school system. As a result, returning back to school can be difficult and unpredictable.

Our volunteers at Southeast Nebraska CASA are in frequent contact with teachers and school administrators to form a partnership to better understand the child's unique strengths and challenges. These interactions with the child's school, combined with the volunteer's relationship with the child, empower our volunteers to advocate in court for what the child needs to thrive academically. Our goal is not only to advocate in court, but also in the classroom. Our volunteers help to make sure the children we serve have everything they need to learn and perform in the classroom.

CASA Talk


The Official Podcast of Southeast Nebraska CASA




