A Letter from Our Director...

The Storms in June are nothing compared to what some kids go through - EVERY DAY.

June was a bit "Stormy" at Southeast Nebraska CASA. Our Seward Office sustained a lot of damage from a tornado/hail storm on June 14th and we are all working at home while waiting on the repairs. We are thankful, no one was hurt in the storm and we are reminded that the children we serve at Southeast Nebraska CASA sometimes live in stormy situations EVERYDAY. However, the storms the kids see every day can't be fixed with a contractor. They need a support network. They need dedicated caseworkers, GALs, foster parents and THEY NEED A CASA VOLUNTEER.

CASA volunteers play a critical role in the lives of children. CASA volunteers are appointed by judges and they get to know the child and talk to family members and other adults in the child's life to find out what they need to heal and thrive.

Children in foster care may have experienced physical, psychological and/or emotional trauma, and may endure long periods of uncertainty in the system as they wait to go home, be adopted or see what happens next. Our highly trained CASA volunteers step up to provide judges with the information they need to act in the best interest of the child.

Having a CASA volunteer, a caring consistent adult - someone who listens, checks in, follows up, holds the system accountable and puts the child's best interest before all others, can make all the difference.

While our CASA volunteer can't always "Fix" the storm for the child, our volunteers do advocate and champion for the safety of that child, so the kids can find the safe, happy, healthy homes built with resources to help them thrive


RESILIENCE PART TWO WITH KIM MARXHAUSEN
